Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to regulate, provide guidance and address growing concerns of the use of bicycles, skateboards, roller skates, in-line skates, ‘heelies’, scooters, small vehicles, and to establish regulations/procedures on dealing with the safe application and use thereof while on campus.

Scope:

This policy applies to all Academy students, faculty, staff and guests.

Accountability:

Academy Police, Faculty, and Staff in conjunction with the Corp of Cadets will be responsible for the adherence to and enforcement of this policy.

Policy Statement:

It is the policy of the Academy to regulate the use of alternative modes of transportation in accordance with Title V of the California Code of Regulations, California Education Code, California Vehicle Code, and Academy Parking & Traffic Regulations.
