Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to establish rules and regulations regarding the operation and parking of vehicles on Academy property.

Scope: This policy applies to anyone operating any motor vehicle on campus.

Accountability: Everyone utilizing campus parking facilities must follow regulations and pay their fair share. Administration and daily operation of the campus parking and traffic programs are the responsibility of Police Services.

Policy Statement: It is the policy of the Academy to regulate traffic and parking at all times on its property in accordance with Title V of the California Administrative Code, California Vehicle Code (CVC), and Academy Parking & Alternative Transportation Regulations. The latest set of approved Academy regulations may be found in the Parking & Alternative Transportation Regulations section of the current Academy Student Handbook.
